16-man brackets will wrestle rounds 6-7-8

8- man brackets will wrestle rounds 6-7-8

4-man brackets will wrestle rounds 7-8

2 and 3 man brackets will wrestle as

round robins (best 2 out of 3).rounds 6-7-8

Admission:
